



















The ceremony ended with our DG & DRR guiding us and wishing us good luck on this new journey!










As Rotaractors, we got awareness about hepatitis, its types and causes of it.

Project Summary - A menstrual health awareness programme.

Project Description -

We, the Rotaract club of Bangalore JP Nagar in association with Rotaract club of Ambarnath(RI Dist.3142) were all pumped up for the first Youth Service Project which took place in Sarakki Government School. The occasion was graced by our beloved DRR Rtr. Anurag Patwary. Our Youth Service Director started the session by educating the girls of 13-14 age group on menstrual health and hygiene. We discussed how it is still a taboo topic in their homes. We learnt from their teacher that they miss school every month for 5-7 days and over 30 days the first time they start menstruation. We distributed handouts which covered all the important questions and answers for them to refer later in both Kannada and English. We empowered 153 girls by distributing 1530 sanitary pads. At the end, we were happy to see that those girls did not shy away to take them nor did they find the need to hide those pads.Educate. Empower. Let's say it together- Go with the flow-PERIOD!

MENSTRUAL HEALTH

What is menstruation?

- An indication that a girl is approaching maturity. . The shedding of tissue and blood from the lining of the
- womb through a woman's vagina.
- · Menstruation is a normal & natural part of biological
- . The blood and tissue that comes from the uterus when fertilization does not occur.
- · The monthly self-cleaning action of a healthy uterus.

Menstruation is NOT:

- · An illness or a curse
- Shameful
- · A reason to keep girls and women from school, household activities, or work

Why using cloth during periods is not a good option?

- . Urinary tract infections & fungal infection- if the cloth is not washed &
- dried completely with hygiene . Difficulty in changing them in schools & could cause leakage

Common symptoms that occur before or at the onset of menstruation:

- . General weakness of the body; body feels heavy. . Dizziness, nausea, cramps/lower abdominal pain,
- · Headache, enlarged and painful breasts, fever.
- · Backache, irritability, depression, tiredness, pimples.

Menstrual hygiene is important because it: · Prevents infection and body odour.

- . Enables women to remain healthy, feel comfortable. confident and stay fresh all day.







Some questions you might have

Q: Is it risky or dangerous to engage in sports and games during menstruation? A: No, but if you feel tired or weak and feel the need to rest then rest is advised.

O: Are girls unclean and impure during periods?

A: There is no impurity in the blood associated with menstruation. Cleanliness and hygiene are important to the menstrual flow, to keep away any odor or infection

Q: At what age does a girl start menstruating? A: Most girls get their first period when they're

between 10 and 15 years old. The average age is 12. but every girl's body has its own schedule.

Q: What kinds of foods should be consumed during periods?

A: Eat everyday foods such as vegetables, roti, rice, pulses and lots of fibre and drink plenty of water.

O: How often do girls get their periods & how long do they last for?

A: Some women menstruate every 28 days, while others have longer cycles (35 days) or shorter cycles (21 days). Periods usually last from 2-7 days, with five days being the average length of

O: What can I do when my periods are irregular or have problems related to menstrual health?

A: Talk to an adult and meet a gynaecologist.
